

Part of our social path, we engaged in two initiatives, that are close to our hearts: helping families rebuild their homes after the Beirut blast and donating diesel to hospitals.



We partnered up with a Lebanese NGO to help mitigate the damages caused by the port blast, by supporting the reconstruction of **161** apartments.

Hand in hand we can look for a better Lebanon!

This summer and with the aim of spreading positive vibes despite the difficult context, we supported the *Ciné Caravane* operation that introduces cinema culture to people who stay in remote areas.

This operation, managed by the French Institute of Lebanon, consists of organizing **outdoor film screenings** targeting Lebanese who live in different remote villages and do not have access to this kind of entertainment.

We have joined forces with the Lebanese healthcare system with the aim of supporting medical teams who played a pillar role in the fight against Covid-19 and ensuring the sector's continuity by **donating, in 2020 and 2021, more than 850,000 liters of diesel to 8 private and public hospitals** across the Lebanese territory.

A safe transport

Transport is an integral part of our operations, and we deploy every effort to ensure a **safe transport service**. Exchange meetings are continuously held between the management of Total Liban and the contracted transporters to closely monitor the application of the **safety measures** to ensure a safe transport of our petroleum products at all times.



Did you know?



All transport contractors are **audited** and **certified** by TotalEnergies experts;



All trucks comply with **ADR specifications**; ADR is the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road;



All trucks are equipped with **GPS** to be able to locate customers' orders at any given time. The GPS system also allows to control the driver's speed for a safe service;



All trucks are equipped with two **cameras**: a road camera that records the activity outside the truck and a cabin camera that records the driver's behavior;



All drivers undergo a **medical check** since we are committed to protecting people and goods. Drivers are also yearly **trained** on safe driving behaviors and Hygiene, Safety, Environment, and Quality aspects while transporting petroleum goods.



Fuel storing risks

Storing gasoline and diesel at home can put you and your family in **danger**. These products emit **flammable vapors** that can explode when in contact with any spark. If inhaled these vapors can also cause health problems.

TotalEnergies partnerships towards sustainability

TotalEnergies and Uber* partnered in June to accelerate the transition of Uber's drivers towards electric mobility, by providing support for vehicle conversion and easier access to charge points.

This partnership targets France at first; Uber has set an objective to reach by 2025 50% of electric vehicles available on its French platform. Meanwhile, TotalEnergies is already strongly involved in charging services and infrastructures in major European cities and throughout France. Uber drivers, who are currently equipped with electric or plug-in hybrid vehicles, will have access to TotalEnergies **20,000 charge points** in France by end-2021, and more than **75,000** by 2025.

TotalEnergies and Veolia* have joined forces in July to accelerate the development of microalgae cultivation using CO₂ to produce next-generation biofuels.

The two partners will develop a four-year research project at the La Mède biorefinery, operated by TotalEnergies, with the long-term goal of producing biofuel.

Through photosynthesis, **microalgae use sunlight and CO₂** from the atmosphere or from industrial processes to grow. When mature, they can be transformed into **next-generation biofuels with low carbon intensity**.

Veolia will therefore bring its expertise in:

-  The water sector to optimize management of the microalgae's aquatic environment;
-  The development of algal biomass as an effective solution for CO₂ capture.

-  The cultivation and refining of biomass to produce advanced biofuels;
-  CO₂ capture and utilization technologies.
